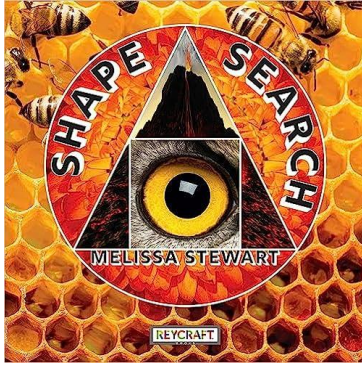


Shape Search

Before You Read

Invite children to look carefully at the cover. What do they think the book will be about? What do the images on the cover have in common? How are they different?

As You Read

Encourage children to think of other objects with the shape discussed on each page. Can they spot objects with each shape in the room where you're reading the book?

After You Read

Take a nature walk and hunt for objects with the shapes discussed. Encourage children to take photos or draw pictures of the objects they spot. Later, you can work together to create a scrapbook of the images.
